Stage 2 Time Trial – Folsom, CA

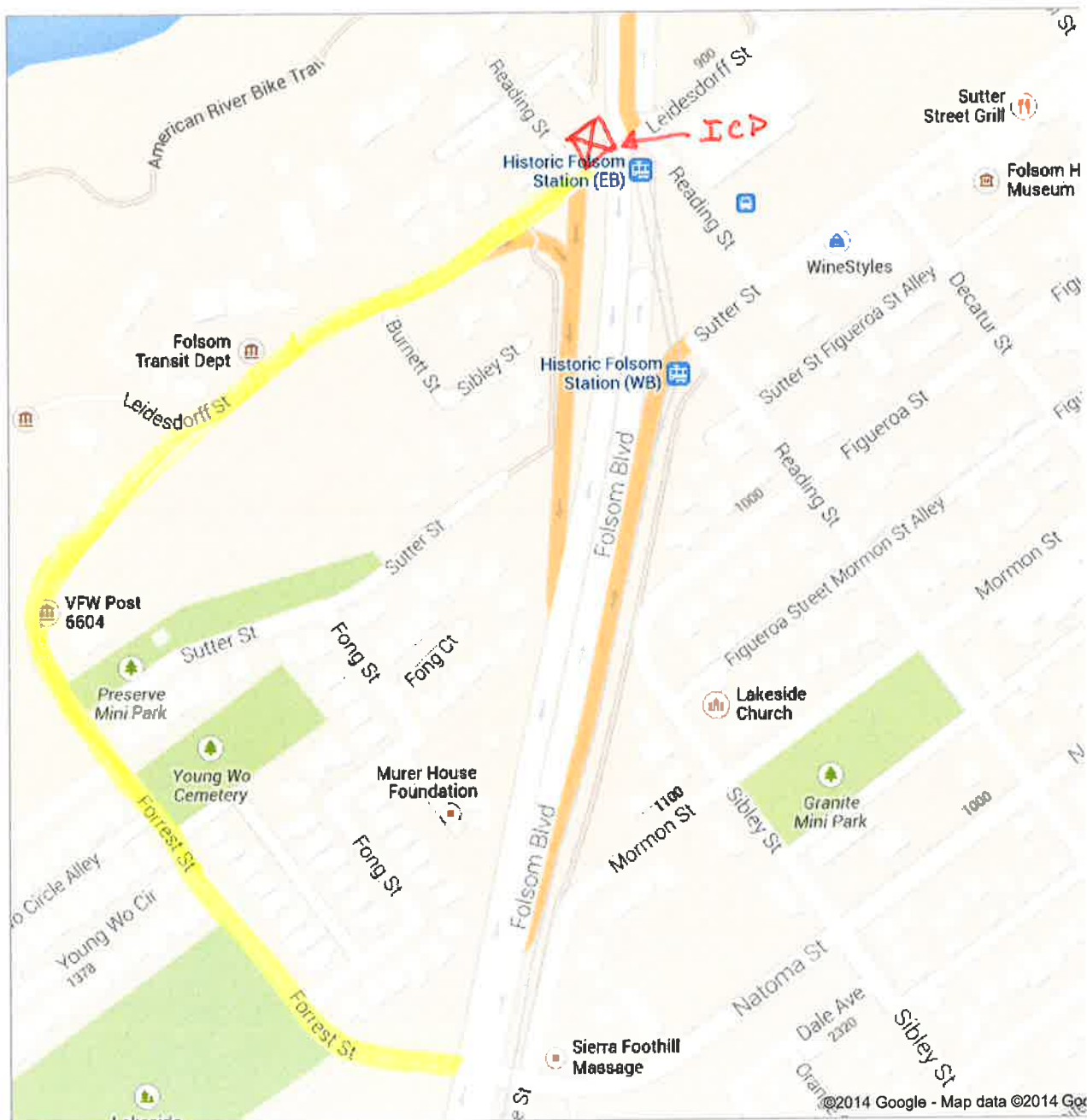

## City Hall Counters/EOC Call Center FAQ's

### What are the start times for Folsom's Time Trial?

10 am – up to 50 amateur riders start at 30-second intervals

11 am – 25 of the world's fastest professional women riders start at one-minute intervals

1:05 p.m. -- 128 of the world's top professional men start at one-minute intervals; last 10 at two-minute intervals

### What is the route?

The 12.5-mile route will start near Snooks Candy on Sutter Street, followed by a turn onto Riley and a short downhill run onto the Rainbow Bridge and over the American River. The route will then turn north on Folsom Auburn Road toward Folsom Lake. A right turn onto Folsom Lake Crossing will take the riders past the prison. A turn onto Green Valley will lead the riders to a 180-degree turn back over the same route to finish in front of Karen's on Leidesdorff Street.



### What roads will be closed?

The following roads will be impacted between 9 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on May 12:

- Rainbow Bridge and Folsom Lake Crossing closed
- Lake Natoma Crossing limited to one lane per direction
- Folsom-Auburn Rd limited to one southbound lane (no northbound traffic)
- East Natoma St closed between Folsom Lake Crossing and Blue Ravine
- Green Valley Rd closed between the County line and East Natoma St
- Riley St closed between Sutter St and Leidesdorff St in the Historic District

**What can I do if I am stuck in traffic and need directions for alternate routes on race day?**  
*Motorists who have race day questions about traffic or alternate routes may call (916) 608-6222 between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Monday, May 12. City staff will answer questions and provide race related traffic information.*

**Where are the best places to view the Time Trial?**

Expect large crowds at the start/finish lines in Historic Folsom. Excellent alternative viewing options include:

- Either side of Rainbow Bridge (but not on it for safety reasons)
- Folsom Lake Crossing Bridge (lots of room, safe and beautiful)
- Lake Natoma Crossing (upstream side)
- Turn-around on Green Valley Road near County Line
- East Natoma between Folsom Lake Crossing and Green Valley roads

**What's happening in the Historic District?**

Large crowds will gather near the start and finish lines, and at the festival area between 10 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Enjoy music, food, vendors and an up-close look at the world's top professional cyclists as they warm up. Start ceremonies for the men's professional Time Trial begin at 12:50 p.m. A post-race awards ceremony will be held in the amphitheater at approximately 3:55 p.m.

**Where can I park?**

Folsom's Historic District is the focal point for the race, and City officials expect 10,000 people or more to gather there to view the start and finish and participate in the festival. Attendees may take Light Rail to Historic Folsom, or walk or ride bikes from the following parking locations:

- Walmart, Kohl's and Lembi Park on Riley St
- Negro Bar State Park on Greenback Lane (\$5 fee helps support California State Parks)
- Folsom Civic Center (City Hall, Library, Rodeo Arena)
- On-street parking on public streets south of Natoma St (park legally and be considerate of residents and businesses)

Spectators may also park on the vacant lot on Blue Ravine across from Manseau (easy access to view race on East Natoma & Green Valley).

**Please Note:** *Event parking will NOT be allowed on Historic District residential streets between Natoma and Figueroa. Parking enforcement will occur on race day.*

**ADA parking** will be available behind Cloud's and the Sutter Street Steakhouse (enter off Riley/Greenback Lane or Scott Street prior to 9 a.m.

**Bike Valet parking available at three locations in the Historic District** – on Scott Street near Sutter, on Reading near Sutter, and just off the American River Trail by Folsom Blvd. Watch for signs.

**Will Light Rail be available?**

Yes. Spectators may take light rail to the Historic Folsom Station from Glenn Drive, Iron Point Road or Hazel. (Sacramento-bound commuters will NOT be able to park at the Historic Folsom

Station. Please park at Glenn, Iron Point or Hazel stations. Regional Transit advises that the Hazel Station has ample parking.)

### **Why is this event important for Folsom?**

Hosting the Time Trial is a partnership between the City, Chamber of Commerce, Tourism Bureau and local sponsors. It is an honor to be selected as one of just 12 host cities in the state for America's largest and most prestigious cycling event. Serving as a host city provides a unique opportunity to showcase our bicycle friendly community before a world-wide television audience and a large number of cycling fans who will come to Folsom for the race. Our association with this premier sporting event will make our community even more attractive to businesses looking to relocate to a world-class city.

### **Who made the decision to host this event?**

The City Council approved Folsom's bid to host the Individual Time Trial for the Amgen Tour of California.

### **Will this be an annual event?**

No. The race course varies each year. Folsom may host some aspect of the race in the future, but it would be unlikely to be another Time Trial on this course.

### **What is the Amgen Tour of California?**

The Amgen Tour of California is a Tour de France-style cycling road race created and presented by AEG that challenges the world's top professional cycling teams to compete along a demanding course that traverses hundreds of miles of California's iconic highways, byways and coastlines each spring. The teams chosen to participate have included Olympic medalists, Tour de France contenders and World Champions. ### **What is an Individual Time Trial?**

A time trial is a bicycle road race where cyclists start at one-minute intervals and race against the clock. The event is often called the "race of truth" as winning depends only on a rider's strength and endurance, and not on help from teammates.
