Information is listed for how to spectate at Stage 1 and 5 of the enduro competition.

Please note that spectators are required to purchase a daily lift pass. Spectators who are accessing the mountain on foot can [purchase a discounted \\$21 spectator ticket online](#) (bike transport not included).

USAC WEEK VOLUNTEER BONUS!

Volunteer for lift, activity, or spectator ticket vouchers during the 2022 USA Cycling Mountain Bike Nationals and receive 1 voucher for every 4 hours* of cumulative volunteer time when you redeem and use your vouchers on or before 7/24/2022.

*Offer valid only for volunteer hours worked and vouchers redeemed during the week of July 18-24, 2022. Vouchers may be redeemed for Trestle Bike Park or Spectator/Activity tickets.

If volunteer hours worked during USAC Nationals are NOT redeemed for vouchers to be used by 7/24/2022, or surplus hours remain, these hours will be entered into the voucher tracking system at a rate of 1 voucher per 6 hours of cumulative service, are valid through 12/31/2024, and may be redeemed for winter/summer lift tickets or summer activities at Winter Park Resort and Trestle Bike Park.

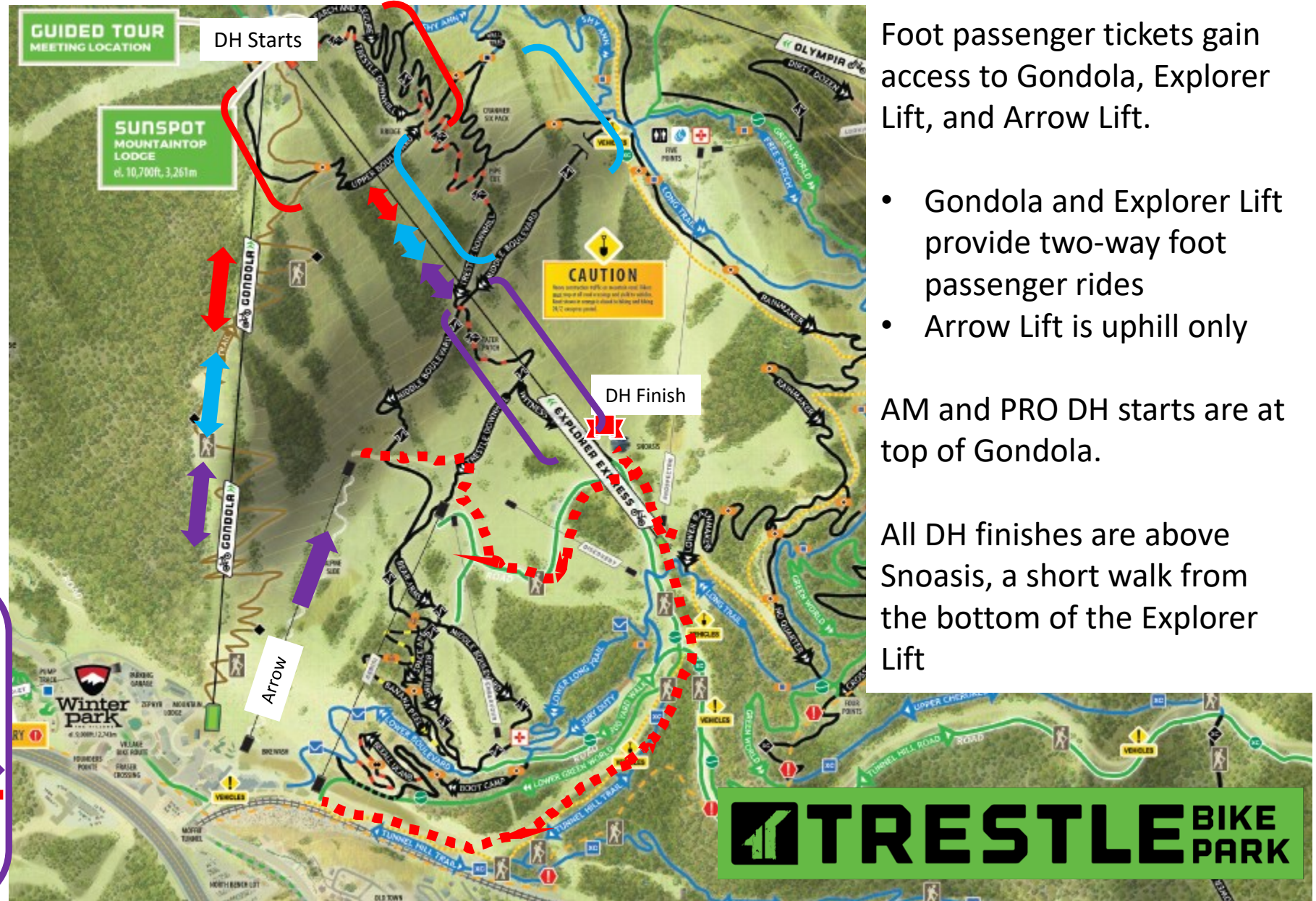

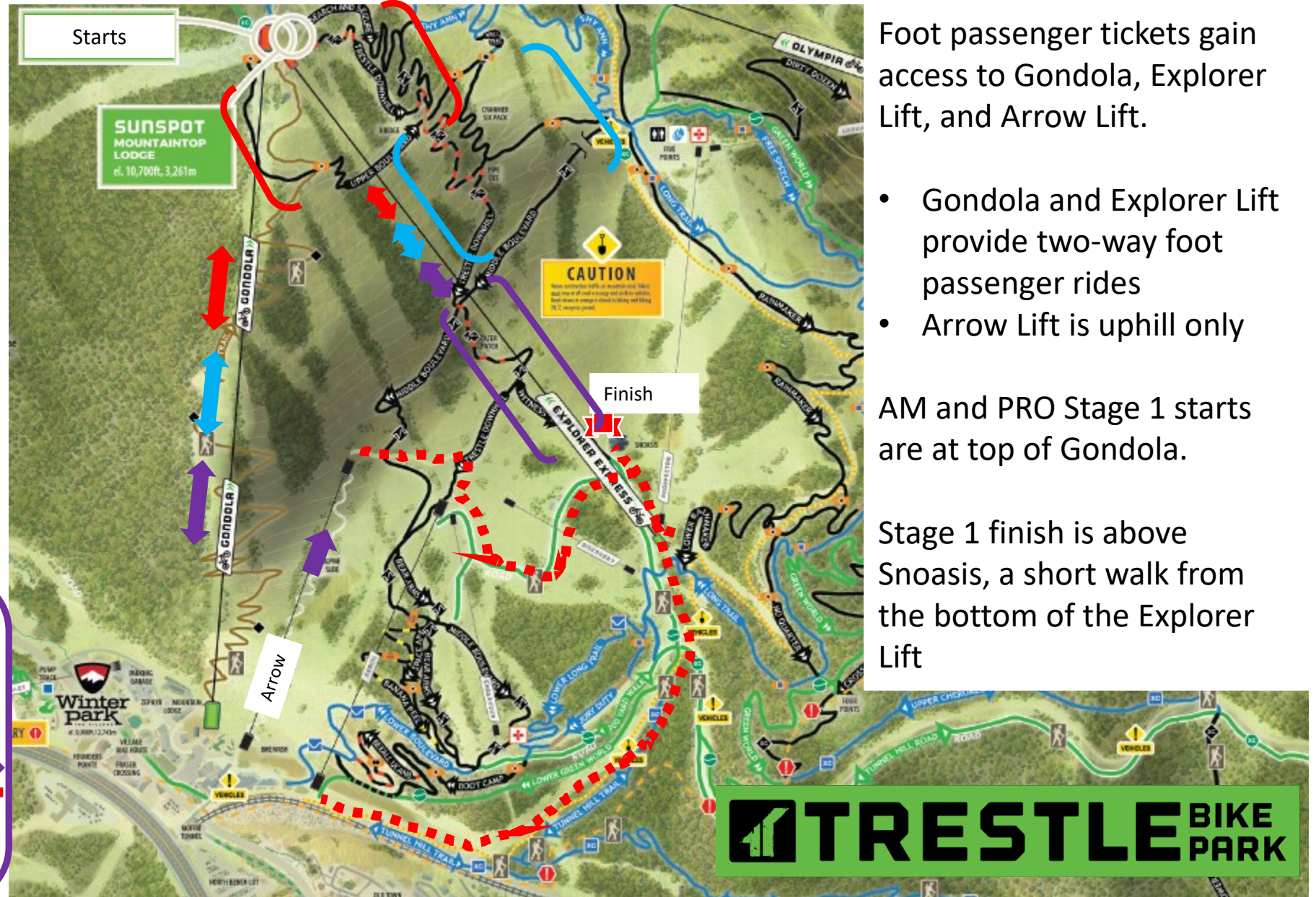

AM and PRO Stage 1 starts are at top of Gondola.

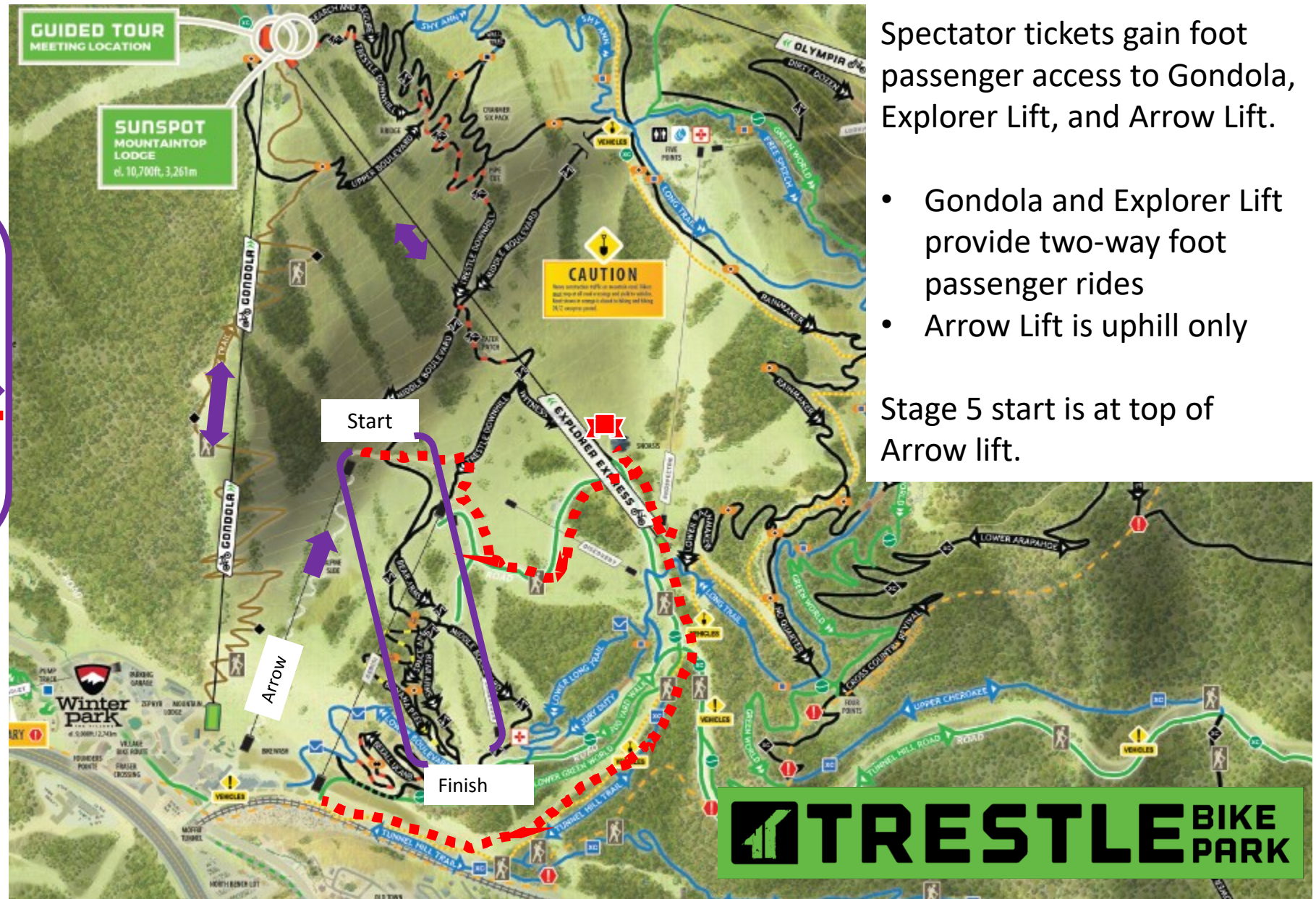
Stage 1 finish is above Snoasis, a short walk from the bottom of the Explorer Lift
