

## **ELIGIBILITY**

**Pro/Elite Men and Pro/Elite/U23 Women:** Must be a United States citizen, with USA Sporting Nationality, and a racing age of 19 or older.

- Men must be a member of a UCI registered trade team, a member of a registered Domestic Elite Team or meet the qualification criteria below.
- Women must be a member of a UCI registered trade team, be a member of registered USA Cycling Domestic Elite Team, or Road Category 1 or Category 2.

## **LICENSING**

**License:** Riders must have a current **USA Cycling International License or Professional Road License\*** or a valid UCI Foreign Federation license indicating a **USA** sporting nationality with a **UCI ID**. Riders **must** obtain a 2022 USA Cycling International License, if required, prior to picking up their packet at race registration. Please log into your USA Cycling account to upgrade your domestic license.

\* <u>U23 women</u> may hold a **USA Cycling Domestic Annual License** with a <u>UCI ID</u>\*

# **REGULATION INFORMATION**

**Road Race and Time Trials:** Conducted under UCI Regulations, including UCI equipment regulations. Radios are specifically allowed in both competitions by all riders.

**Criteriums:** All races will be run under USA Cycling Regulations. Please review the National Championship rules in the USA Cycling rulebook.

#### **Vehicles and Drivers:**

- For the Time Trial, drivers of follow cars must have a current license from any recognized
  National Federation and be current on USA Cycling's Caravan Safety Training which will be
  offered during the event virtually or in-person. Although the UCI height requirement is not in
  force for time trials, extremely large vehicles (i.e. 15 passenger vans) are prohibited.
- For the Road Race, <u>only UCI and Domestic Elite Teams will be allowed cars, conforming with UCI regulations, in the caravan.</u> Drivers must hold a USA Cycling-UCI Support License and be current on USA Cycling's Caravan Safety Training which will be offered during the event. Please note that the USA Cycling support license requires SafeSport certification and a Background Check which may take several days to return.

# **U23 MEN AND WOMEN**

**Women:** The top U23 Woman (WU) will be scored with the elite women for each event with recognition for the top U23 Woman as the U23 National Champion. A separate podium ceremony for the top-three U23 woman will be conducted with the overall women's awards ceremony each day.

**Men:** Per UCI regulation 1.2.028, USA Cycling has determined that U23 riders may compete in both U23 and Elite championship events, without restriction. The men's U23 title will be awarded at the separate U23 National Championships.
