I shall submit to disciplinary measures taken against me and shall take any appeals and litigation before the authorities provided for in the regulations. With that reservation, I shall submit any litigation with the UCI exclusively to the tribunals at UCI headquarters. I further agree that the results of the analysis may be released to the public and communicated to my trade team, coach, or doctor in accordance with UCI and WADA regulations. I agree to allow my doctor and/or the doctor of my team, upon the request of the UCI or WADA, to release to UCI and WADA officials a list of medications or treatments administered to me before any specific competition.
